### Softball Player of the Week

#### Stacia Saniuk, Bates

(Senior, 3B/DP - Sharon, Mass.)

Saniuk batted .778 (7-for-9) and posted a 1.444 slugging percentage along with a .867 on-base percentage during a 3-1 week for the Bobcats. She hit two home runs, recorded six walks, had four RBI and four runs scored. Saniuk hit her 20th career homer on Sunday against Me.-Farmington, extending her program-record mark. She has currently reached base in six straight plate appearances.

### Softball Pitcher of the Week

#### Lauren Gelmetti, Tufts

(Senior, LHP - Westfield, N.J.)

Gelmetti won starts against Springfield, Bridgewater St. and Trinity last week for the Jumbos, posting a 0.56 ERA over 16.0 IP and tossing two complete games. She held opposing batters to a .118 average as she gave up six hits and seven walks while striking out 12. Gelmetti came within one out of pitching a no-hitter during Saturday's 8-0 win over Trinity.

**Notes:** Amherst first year catcher Carly Dudzik (Darien, Conn.) went 3-for-7 (.429) with a double, a run scored and a run batted in during a series split with Hamilton on Sunday. Junior 1B/P Alex Chang-Graham (San Carlos, Calif.) earned a complete-game victory during game one of the Hamilton series on Sunday. She gave up one unearned run while striking out six batters...Bates first year RHP Kristen Finn (Winthrop, Mass.) went 2-0 with a 1.75 ERA over 12.0 IP, holding opponents to a .196 average as she struck out seven. Finn pitched a no-hitter in the Bobcats' five-inning, 10-0 win over Me.-Farmington on Sunday, a day after her complete-game victory over Colby...Bowdoin's Clare Ronan (Jenkintown, Pa.) batted .462 over four games, as she hit a pair of home runs and collected seven RBIs for the Polar Bears...Hamilton senior pitcher Megan Coughlin (Clifton Park, N.Y.) batted .556 (5-for-9) with a 1.333 slugging and .600 on-base percentage mark. She also went 2-1 from the rubber, posting an ERA of 2.33 over 21.0 IP as she recorded 20 strikeouts while surrendering 18 hits, four walks, and holding opponents to a .220 average. Coughlin almost single-handedly led the Continentals to a 4-1 win over Amherst in game two on Sunday, as she hit two home runs, drove in three, and pitched her second complete game of the day...Middlebury first year Alyson Downing (Rumney, N.H.) hit .417 over five games for the Panthers last week, adding a double and posting a .462 OBP. Sophomore pitcher Ali McAnaney (Northbrook, Ill.) went 3-1 over six appearances with a 1.24 ERA in 22.2 innings pitched, allowing nine hits and five walks while striking out 16. Geena Constantin (Pelham, N.H.) tied the program record for strikeouts in a game with 15 in a victory over Skidmore on Tuesday...Tufts junior SS Casey Sullivan (Berlin, Conn.) recorded a hit in every game of the Jumbos' 6-0 week, batting .500 (9-for-18) with a .571 OBP and an .889 slugging percentage. Sullivan had four doubles, a home run, three walks, three stolen bases, nine RBI and five runs scored. At shortstop, Sullivan fielded 31 of 32 opportunities cleanly for the week...Wesleyan sophomore DP/P Anu Rimal (Belle Mead, N.J.) batted .500 over three wins (5-for-10) last week and was called upon to make her first pitching appearance of the season. In 7.0 IP, Rimal recorded seven strikeouts while giving up only five hits, two walks, and two runs, none of which were earned. Junior P/2B Meaghan Dendy (Swansea, Mass.) posted her first shutout in her 40th career start, limiting Middlebury to four hits and striking out six in a 4-0 win on Saturday. She also extended her hitting streak to 19 games during the series, every game the Cardinals have played so far this season...Williams senior Joey Lye (Toronto, Ontario) became the all-time leader in stolen bases at Williams last week with five steals (51). She broke the record of 48 set by Laura Brenneman '99.
