### Softball Player of the Week

#### Alyssa Lepore, Colby

(Sophomore, DP - Victor, N.Y.)

Lepore batted .667 (12-for-18) during a 4-1 week for the Mules, collecting eight extra-base hits among her 12 with six doubles and two home runs. Lepore also walked three times for an on-base percentage of .714 while also recording six runs and seven RBI. In the three-game series with Trinity, Lepore went 7-for-11.

### Softball Pitcher of the Week

#### Lauren Gelmetti, Tufts

(Senior, LHP - Westfield, N.J.)

In three appearances for the Jumbos last week, Gelmetti went 2-0 with a save over 12.2 IP, holding opposing batters to a .091 average. She recorded 16 strikeouts while giving up no runs and only allowing four hits and three walks. She earned the save in Saturday's second game against Bowdoin, coming into a 6-3 affair with the bases loaded and recording two outs.

**Notes:** Plenty of questions still need to be answered during the final week of the regular season before the start of the **2009 NESCAC Softball Championship**. Two-time defending champ Tufts locked up the number-one seed over a week ago and finished the season a perfect 12-0 in conference play after a weekend sweep of Bowdoin. The top seed in the East Division, the Jumbos will host this year's tournament May 1-3. The team that will join Tufts from the East will be decided this week when Bates hosts Trinity. Over in the West, a three-way tie for first has created a logjam atop the standings. Amherst will face Williams this weekend while Wesleyan will take on Hamilton...**Amherst** first year SS Carly Dudzik (Darien, Conn.) led the Jeffs at the plate during a 4-1 week, batting .611 (11-for-18) with a double, a triple, a home run, two walks, eight runs scored and 10 RBI. She has had at least two hits in each of the past six games. Junior pitcher Alex Chang-Graham (San Carlos, Calif.) went 3-1 over four starts last week, posting a 3.00 ERA and holding opposing batters to a .233 average. In 21.0 IP, Chang-Graham struck out 21 while allowing 21 hits...**Bates** senior 3B/DP Stacia Saniuk (Sharon, Mass.) is one hit shy of tying the Bobcats' career record of 110 held by Krissie Whiting '03. Saniuk already owns program records for all-time home runs (20), extra base hits (43), total bases (195) and walks (32)...**Bowdoin's** Alison Coleman (Lewiston, Maine) batted .435 and slugged .739 with eight RBI in seven games last week...**Hamilton** sophomore catcher Amber O'Connor (Pembroke, Ontario) set the career record for runs (79) and hits (134) last week while tying the program record for stolen bases (38). O'Connor has 13 stolen bases so far this season. Senior pitcher Megan Coughlin (Clifton Park, N.Y.) moved into first place for all-time strikeouts for the Continentals during a doubleheader split with St. Lawrence on Wednesday. Coughlin now has 314...**Middlebury** first year Kira Gordon (Scarborough, Maine) batted .455 last week for the Panthers...**Trinity** senior catcher Ariana Mullin (Woodbridge, Conn.) batted .294 (5for-17) with a .429 on-base percentage and a .882 slugging percentage during a 3-2 week. She hit three home runs, a double, walked four times, scored five runs and drove in six. First year Katherine Poulos (Wilton, Conn.) had the decision in all five of the Bantams' games last week, going 3-2 with a 1.50 ERA over 28.0 IP. She surrendered 26 hits and six earned runs while giving up 11 walks and striking out seven...**Tufts** first year UT Lena Cantone (Southington, Conn.) batted .632 (12-for-19) with a .636 on-base percentage and a 1.000 slugging percentage. She hit two doubles, a triple, a home run, walked twice, scored four runs and recorded 12 RBI...**Wesleyan** sophomore Chelsea Swete (Glenmont, N.Y.) had two strong outings for the Cardinals last week, tossing 13 innings while yielding just three earned runs and recording nine strikeouts...**Williams** senior 3B Morgan Simpson (McLean, Va.) hit .611 (11-for-18) with two doubles, a triple, a home run, 10 RBI and four runs scored. Senior Joey Lye (Toronto, Ontario) set a program record for career hits last week, surpassing Laura Jacobs '99 mark of 185.
