GUIDELINES

- Consult the CMS website (ase.tufts.edu/cms) for specific requirements for each of the CMS minors.
- Students who intend to minor in Mass Communications and Media Studies should take the core course, Media and Society (Sociology 40), as early as possible in their academic career.
- Students who intend to minor in Film Studies should take the core course, Introduction to Film Studies (Drama 50/ILVS 50), as early as possible in their academic career.
- Students who intend to minor in Multimedia Arts should contact the Director of the MMA minor, Howard Woolf (howard.woolf@tufts.edu), as early as possible to review course requirements.
- A course taken for one of the CMS minors must be taken for a letter grade (with the exception of EXP99C and EXP190C, which can only be taken pass/fail).
- Courses taken as part of a minor must be taken for full credit. Exceptions are EXP190C, which is half-credit only, and EXP99CA in the summer. However, in order for an EXP99C internship to count for a minor, it must either be taken for full credit or be combined with another half-credit media course or internship to equal a full credit.
- Students may double count a maximum of two credits from a CMS minor toward a major, another minor, or distribution requirements.
- Students cannot count courses used as foundation requirements towards a CMS minor, nor can courses used for the CMS minor also be counted as foundation requirements.
- A maximum of three courses taken outside of Tufts may be applied toward a CMS minor.
