Choose between

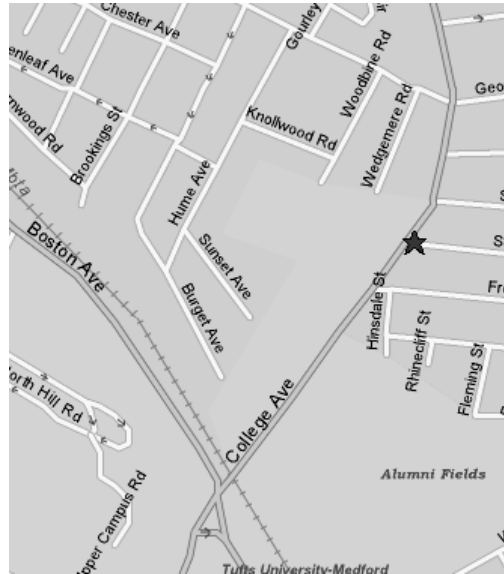
The morning *Virtual Home* session where you learn to design your own home on the computer

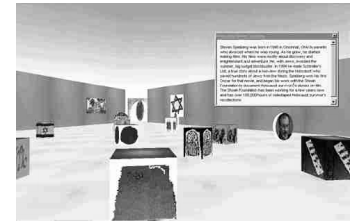
