

How Dance Courses Apply to Tufts Requirements/Other Programs:

1-Arts Distribution: all dance courses

2-Culture and World Civ: West African Dance, North Indian, Kathak, The Art of Salsa, and Special Topics Intermediate Salsa. Take two of these .5 credit courses during your four years to fulfill one credit of World Civ. The African courses and the salsas can also be applied to one credit of the culture requirement. Special topics may require a petition to the Academic Review Board.

4. Other Programs: Spanish and IR have been petitioned by students who wish to fulfill certain of their requirements with salsa. Viewing African American Dance and the West African studio courses may be applied to the Africa and the New World Minor. Check with Latino Studies and Latin American Studies for any salsa credit application.

5. Some dance courses may be used toward the Drama major, toward certain versions of the American Studies major, and toward the Plan of Study--an independently constructed major administrated by the Center for Interdisciplinary Studies.
