

ENGLISH DEPARTMENT MINOR

Due April 15th (senior year)

The Minor in English requires students to take **six** courses in the Department. Fulfillment of the Writing Requirement is a prerequisite for upper-level English courses. English 1, 2, 3, and 4 do *not* count toward the Minor. The purpose of the minor is to allow students to experiment widely or to follow a particular interest with some concentration. Therefore each minor will be individual not only in content but also in concept. To that end, all students are expected to plan a coherent program of study that leads to breadth, pursues a specialized interest, or combines these two objectives. Whatever course of study they construct, students are encouraged to include at least one course numbered below 100 and one above 100 and to consult with faculty members as they pursue their minors. Up to two courses may be transferred from an outside institution to be submitted for minor credit. Beginning with the class of 2007, students may count a maximum of three creative writing courses towards fulfillment of the Minor in English.
