Marching cards will be available for pick-up Tuesday, May 15th – Friday, May 18th from 9:00 a.m. – 4:30 p.m. Please be sure to bring a photo ID. If someone else will pick-up your card and tickets for you, please inform the OGS via email at least one day prior.
