

# MINOR IN CHINESE

(Updated April, 2009)

The minor requires 6 courses beyond Chinese 4 with grades of C or above, including two 100-level language courses and two literature/culture courses. Students should declare their intentions to minor no later than the spring semester of their junior year.

## Note that

1. No more than 2 courses fulfilling a foundation, distribution, or concentration requirement can be used to fulfill minor requirements.

Asian Studies (Chinese) majors are thus advised that since Chinese 21,22, 121, and 122 count towards their major, they need to choose within the following parameters: i/ 2-4 language courses from 121-128, ii/ 4-2 lit/culture courses that are not used to fulfill their major requirements.
