

Dear Health Care Provider:

Your patient has been accepted to Tufts University.

Please see the reverse side of this letter to review Tufts University medical requirements and recommendations for graduate students.

Graduate students are required to submit a current TB risk assessment, performed by a clinician, within the past 12 months and an up to date immunization record. The required immunizations (see reverse side) are in compliance with Massachusetts law, and must be complete in order to attend Tufts University. Entering graduate students are required to receive the full Hepatitis B immunization series, and two doses of Measles, Mumps and Rubella vaccine (MMR) and an updated tetanus immunization. Please note that graduate students who will be living in on-campus housing must be vaccinated against meningococcal disease, or must sign a waiver declining vaccination.

If your patient is being treated for a specific medical condition, we are happy to cooperate with you and continue in his/her management. We would appreciate receiving a summary of his/her record including the diagnosis, recommendations for further evaluations, if any, and treatment plan as indicated.
