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Referral to Psychiatry from a Therapist in Private Practice

Tufts University students who are enrolled in the Medford Campus and have paid the mandatory health fee are eligible to receive their psychiatric care at the Tufts University Health Services (TUHS). If a student has enrolled in the Student Health Insurance Program Tufts, their insurance is billed by TUHS so there is no out-of pocket expense for their ongoing psychiatric care. Students who are covered by other health insurance programs are seen for three free psychiatric visits that are covered by the mandatory health fee. After the first three visits there is a fee to the student. The follow-up visit charges are well below community costs. The TUHS will not bill the students insurance, however, we can provide documentation to allow for the student to get reimbursed directly from their health insurance company.
