



## How to Determine Amount of Funding You Must Show in Order to Get Your Immigration Document

- Subtract any tuition scholarship from your tuition charge (see Estimate of Expenses Form) to get **TOTAL A**
- Subtract any teaching or research assistantship from your living expenses to get **TOTAL B**
- **TOTAL A + TOTAL B** = Remaining amount you must demonstrate in US dollars, using original documents, in order to get your immigration document.

\*Tuition charges are reflected on the accompanying Estimate of Expenses. Please note that if you are a teaching or research assistant, your tuition charge for the 1st academic year is *usually* HALF of the cost listed on the Estimate of Expenses. **(Please check with your department or the Office of Graduate Studies to be certain of your tuition charge.)**

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EXAMPLE ONE:

Masters student in the Graduate School of Arts & Sciences with NO Teaching or Research Assistantship:

Tuition and Fee Charge:	\$38,136	Living Expenses:	\$20,356
Tuition Scholarship:	<u>-\$ 0</u>	TA/RA/GA.:	<u>-\$ 0</u>
TOTAL A	\$38,136	TOTAL B	\$20,356

\$38,136 (TOTAL A) plus \$20,356(TOTAL B) = \$58,492 (Amount to demonstrate you have or are being sponsored for.)

EXAMPLE TWO:

Masters student in the Graduate School of Arts & Sciences with a Teaching Assistantship for \$8,000 for one academic year and a full tuition scholarship.

Tuition and Fee Charge:	\$19,088	Living Expenses:	\$20,356
Tuition Scholarship:	<u>- 19,048</u>	TA/RA/GA.:	<u>\$- 8,000</u>
TOTAL A:	\$ 40	TOTAL B:	\$12,356

\$40 (TOTAL A) plus \$12,356 (TOTAL B) = \$12,396 (Amount to demonstrate you have or are being sponsored for.)

*Please note: not all students will receive a tuition scholarship and/or a Teaching or Research Assistantship.*
