

## **IR DOUBLE MAJOR FORM – OLD CURRICULUM**

Only 50% of the courses taken in one major may be applied toward completion of requirements in a second major. The number of courses permitted toward double-counting is reached by taking half the total of the major with the fewest courses required. For example, students majoring in IR (12 required courses) and History (10 required courses) may only overlap five courses between the two majors. Exceptions:

1. Economics: Because EC 5 is not technically counted toward Economics requirements, but is required of majors as a pre-requisite, the number of courses that may be double-counted between Economics and IR is 4.
2. Language double majors using courses taught in a foreign language (including those taken abroad) beyond the third-year level of instruction can overlap 80% of their courses.
