Connecting to the P: and Q: Drives

Connecting to the P: Drive

- Confirm that the **Finder** menu bar appears at the top of your desktop.
- From the **Go** menu, select **Connect to Server**.
- The **Connect to Server** window will appear.
- In the box labeled **Server Address**, type **smb://titan.tccs.tufts.edu**.
- Click on the button labeled **Connect**.
- The **SMB/CIFS Filesystem Authentication** window will appear.
- In the box labeled **Username**, type your Tufts network account username also known as your UTLN (for example, asmith01).
- In the box labeled **Password**, type your Tufts network account password also known as your LAN password.
- Click on the button labeled **OK**.
- The **SMB Mount** window will appear.
- Confirm that your Tufts network account username appears in the box labeled **Select a share**.
- Click on the button labeled **OK**.
- An icon labeled with your Tufts network account username will appear on your desktop.
- The window labeled with your Tufts network account username will automatically open and allow you to access the files saved to your P: drive.

Connecting to the Q: Drive

- Confirm that the **Finder** menu bar appears at the top of your desktop.
- From the **Go Menu**, select **Connect to Server**.
- The **Connect to Server** window will appear.
- In the box labeled **Server Address**, type **smb://titan.tccs.tufts.edu/[deptshare]** where **[deptshare]** is your department's unique folder name provided by the ITS help desk or your FSP
- Click on the button labeled **OK**.
- The **SMB/CIFS Filesystem Authentication** window will appear.
- In the box labeled **Username**, type your Tufts network account username also known as your UTLN (for example, asmith01).
- In the box labeled **Password**, type your Tufts network account password also known as your LAN password.
- Click on the button labeled **OK**.
- An icon labeled with the name of your department's share will appear on your desktop.
- The window labeled with the name of your department's share will automatically open.

Creating a permanent solution for mapping network drives

- Apple also allows your network drives to map automatically when you log in to your machine. If you are interested in having this configured, please contact the ITS help desk or your department's FSP.
