- I. General Purpose
 - a. To bring joy and laughter to others through humor
 - b. To bring a different aspect of theater to the Tufts community
 - c. To continue to learn and improve our skills
 - d. To support the other campus organizations by offering our services for their causes(ie. Benefit shows, RHA activities, programming board)
- II. Activity
 - a. At least, but not limited to, four on-campus shows a year.
 - b. Opening for the programming board if we are invited.
 - c. Performing in large events such as the "Supershow," Faculty Waits on you dinner etc.
 - d. Performing off campus in and around the Boston area and beyond to wherever we may be able to showcase our talents.
- III. New Members
 - a. New members are let in through audition process.
 - b. Auditions are open to the entire Tufts community, and held in the Fall semester with the possibility, left to the discretion of the troupe, for Spring semester auditions.
 - c. New members are voted in by the existing troupe. A unanimous vote is required to vote in a new member. Troupe members may abstain from voting any time during this process.
- IV. Officers
 - a. Candidates are voted on in the end of the spring semester to determine the officers for the following year.
 - b. The voting process is as follows:
 - i. Nomination of candidate(s)
 - ii. Discussion within the troupe without the candidates present
 - iii. Hand vote
 - c. In case of a tie, discussion is resumed until a consensus is reached among members and voted on again.
- V. Director/Co-Directors
 - a. Oversees the goals of the troupe
 - b. Leads rehearsal and is interested in the creative development of the troupe.
 - c. Organizes the schedules for shows and other performance related topics.
- VI. On-Campus Producer
 - a. Deals with the TCUG and the TCU Budget, becomes the signatory for the group.
 - b. Deals with student activities and TSLV for on-campus shows.
 - c. Is the contact person for the troupe
 - d. Finds and determines rehearsal space, and deals with all other paperwork for the troupe
 - e. Creates all publicity for the troupe including ads, posters, and general announcements
 - f. Works with directors in dealing with and promoting the troupes image and activities.
- VII. Off-Campus Producer
 - a. Arranges off-campus performances
- VIII. Alumni Rep
 - a. Keeps track of, gets in touch with, Cheap Sox Alum
 - b. Adds relevant information to the web site

IX. Impeachment

a. If the need for the impeachment of an officer arises, the issue is brought up to the group,, discussed, and any decision for impeachment will be unanimous.

X. Updating the Constitution

a. Any updates will be made as needed with the consent of the majority of the group, and as approved by the TCU Judiciary.
