

Constitution for "Jumbo Audio Project"

Article I: Title

Section I: The name of the organization shall be Jumbo Audio Project

Article II: Purpose

Section I: The purpose of this organization is to increase the exposure of creative musical works by Tufts students through releasing a musical compilation compact disc

Section II: The Compilation should also provide a diverse selection of music

Section III: Artists included in compilation must be currently attending Tufts University

Section IV: Groups included in compilation must be composed 50% or more of currently enrolled Tufts students.

Article III: Membership

Section I: Membership is for any member of the Tufts Community who has paid the Student Activities Fee

Article IV: Meetings

Section I: Meetings shall be held at times determined by the co-chairs

Article V: Voting

Section I: A voting member is defined as an individual who has attended at least two meetings

Section II: For all voting except when otherwise stated, a majority will rule

Section III: In the event of a tie, the Co-Chairs will decide the outcome

Article VI: Amendments

Section I: Amendments may be proposed by any voting member

Section II: At least two thirds of voting members must be present to vote on an amendment. This process must comply with all Tufts Community Union Judiciary rules and regulations.

Section III: All amendments must be approved by the Tufts Community Union Judiciary

Article VII: Elections

Section I: There shall be two co-chairs of Jumbo Audio Project

Section II: Co-chairs will be elected by a vote in the spring semester

Section III: An executive board of officers shall be chosen by the co-chairs through an application process which is intended to aid the decision process. These positions may include Public Relations officer, Events Coordinator, Art Director, Legal Director, Artist Relations officer, Webmaster

Article VIII: Duties of the co-chairs

Section I: The co-chairs are responsible for running weekly meetings, overseeing general activities including manufacturing and distribution of the CD, and managing the budget and creating a budget for next year

Section II: The Co-chairs have the authority to act on behalf of the organization when matters require immediate action.

Section III: The Co-chairs must also attend all retreats deemed mandatory by the Programming Board and are bound by its constitution as well.

Article IX: Impeachment

Section I: Any voting member may impeach any officer and must gain a signed petition of no less than 5/6 of all voting members

Section II: At least 80% of all voting members shall be present at an impeachment meeting

Section III: Impeachment shall be held valid if a single 2/3 majority is in its favor
