

## **Oxfam Cafe Constitution**

October 24, 1995

### Article I

#### Name

Section 1. The name of this organization is Oxfam Cafe.

### Article II

#### Purpose

Section 1. The first purpose of this organization is to raise funds for Oxfam America, a world-wide hunger-relief organization.

Section 2. The second purpose of this organization is to raise awareness on campus of hunger-related issues.

Section 3. The third purpose of this organization is to provide a place for students to relax and enjoy an inexpensive, healthy meal in a fun atmosphere. The Cafe also makes itself available to student groups for meetings and special events.

### Article III

#### Membership

Section I. Membership is open to any undergraduate member of the Tufts Community who has paid the Student Activities fee.

Section II. Only managers are allowed to vote via consensus process.

### Article IV

#### Meetings

Section I. Managerial meetings will be held on a weekly basis.

Section II. All-Staff meetings will be held as necessary (determined by manager consensus).

### Article V

#### Managers

Section I. Any staff member who wishes to become a manager will have the opportunity to do so. Staff must be given at least a full semester's training before becoming a manager.

Section II. All responsibility at the cafe will be divided by the managers at the weekly meetings and may be designated to other staff members.

Section III. Only managers may deposit or remove cash from the Cafe or the bank account.

### Article VI

#### Impeachment

Section I. Should the activities of a member be inconsistent with basic university regulations or the interests of the group, members of the group may lobby for an impeachment vote. The decision to impeach a member will be decided upon manager consensus.

Article VII  
Amendment

Section I. In the event that a feeling of amending the constitution occurs, there will be a special meeting called to discuss amending the constitution. The decision to amend the constitution will be decided upon manager consensus.

Section II. All amendments must be approved by the TCUJ.
