- (2) the course must be feminist in perspective, making use of scholarship on women and gender relevant to the topic.

If you would like your course(s) to be considered among the Women's Studies offerings, please send us the following information:

- (1) a current syllabus or, for a new course, a reading list if syllabus is not yet available;
- (2) a course description which we can include on our Women's Studies course list and on our web site, including the course number, title, instructor, and time block.

Because we would like to publicize Women's Studies courses in advance of pre-registration, we need your response by **Friday, February 27<sup>th</sup>**.
