# ***Beyond the Classroom Student Forum***

## Information Sheet

### ***Forum information:***

The 24<sup>th</sup> annual Women's Studies ***Beyond the Classroom*** student forum will be held on the afternoon of **Friday, March 27, 2009** (exact time and location to be announced.)

The goal of the forum is to provide a context for sharing with the wider Tufts community the work on women and gender that Tufts undergraduate and graduate students are doing in classes and independent projects across the disciplines.

This year's event will include several panels. If selected, your work will be placed on a panel with other student projects. Each student will do a 5-7 minute presentation (three pages!) of her/his work, followed by a panel-wide discussion period moderated by a faculty member.

We welcome submissions of any length. All submissions (along with a completed and signed submission form) are to be made to the Women's Studies office at 106 Eaton Hall.

The **submission deadline** is **Monday, February 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2009**.

### ***The selection process:***

- A selection committee will carefully consider all of the submissions. Selections will be based upon the quality of work, representation from different disciplines, and how different submissions fit together to create interesting thematic panels. Unfortunately, we often cannot accept all of the excellent work that is submitted and hope that, should your work not be selected this time, you will consider resubmission next year.
- You will receive notification from the Women's Studies Program in mid-March informing you of our decision.
- If your work is selected, the faculty moderator for your panel will meet with you twice prior to the day of the Forum to discuss your presentation and, if necessary, to assist in cutting the work down to 3 pages in length.
- All submitted original work will be returned to students upon request.
