RUSSIAN & EAST EUROPEAN STUDIES MAJOR INSTRUCTIONS AND POLICIES

- **Ten courses required.**
- **Students who place out of Russian 21, 22, 121 and/or 122 on the basis of the language placement exam administered by the Department still need to take 10 courses to complete the major. Students coming back from a semester in Russia are required to take one 100-level course conducted in Russian on return. Students going abroad in the spring of their senior year must take one 100 level course in Russian before leaving.**
- **In place of Russian 121 and 122, the student may substitute Russian 123, 125 or any advanced course related to Russia and Eastern Europe in which all readings are in Russian.**
- **No major course may be taken Pass/Fail.**
- **Students must achieve a grade of C- or better for a course to count for credit toward the major.**
- **If you have more than one major, please see Bulletin for rules on double-counting courses.**
- **If you have a minor, no more than two course credits used toward the minor may be used toward foundation, distribution, major, or other minor requirements.**
